SPANISH LANGUAGE ORGANIZER TRAINING FOR THE IMMIGRATION ORGANIZING PROJECT

The Immigrant Organizing Project is for individuals interested in a career working for social justice as a Union Organizer, particularly with immigrant workers. Participants selected from the Organizing Training will be considered for a paid, organizer apprenticeship program.

Organizers will be on the front lines of the Los Angeles labor movement's efforts to engage immigrant workers who may be eligible for deferred action to access legal services and organize for better workplace conditions.

Spanish Language 3-Day Organizing Training
The curriculum includes basic union organizing skills as well campaign strategy and tactics. Participants will be evaluated through classrooms sessions and interactive role plays.
